IMPROVEMENTS CORNER



Earle Asphalt Company has been contracted by Eastampton Township for the 2022 Road Improvements Program to Knightsbridge Road and various other roads including: Darby Circle East and West, Oxford Court, Berwick Court, Stafford Court, Bedford Court, Suffolk Court, York Court, Prince William Court, Jennifer Court, Rochelle Drive, Ariel Drive, Liat Drive, Christopher Lane, Woodhurst Drive, Honey Locust Lane, Dewberry Drive, Jessica Way, Parkview Drive, Lakeview Terrace, Juniper Street, Carol Court, Hampton Drive, Shelter Rock Road, Cedar Mill Lane, Butternut Court, Knotty Oak Drive, Cedarwood Court, Woodstone Court, and Woodhurst Court.

Work will take place during the hours of **7am-5pm**. The contractor is responsible for notifying all residents within 48 hours prior to construction, and if construction is delayed a new notice will be given out.

During hours of construction, please be advised traffic will be limited. Thru traffic to all homes/businesses will be available, although there will be no direct parking in the designated construction areas. Please follow all signage while operating your vehicle, and use complete caution while walking and driving through all work areas.

The contractor is required by law to call for utility mark-outs prior to the start of construction. Property owners are strongly encouraged to notify Earle of any underground sprinkler systems, underground dog fencing or any other utility that may be unique to your property and not covered by utility mark-outs prior to the start of construction.

The anticipated date for project completion is prior to the first day of the 2023 school year. Please note all work will be done with weather permitting, and each day work is canceled due to weather will result in a delay to the schedule.

RESIDENT CORNER

"No Knock" Solicitation. The Township recognized the need to license and regulate peddlers and solicitors who are conducting business within the Township. The Township also sought to prevent peddlers and solicitors from accessing homes of residents that do not wish to be disturbed through **Ordinance 2019-20.** Chapter 374 of the Township Code amended the license fee for peddlers and solicitors in Eastampton, and established a "No-Knock" list for residents. If you would like to be placed on the "No Knock Registry" please complete the No Knock Application, found on the Municipal Clerk's page at Peddler/Solicitor License | Eastampton New Jersey.

Please Keep Grass Clippings Out of the Street. Residents and landscapers are reminded to keep grass clippings out of the street and the Township's storm drains. Blowing grass and other yard debris into the sidewalk, street, or storm drainage system is a violation of the Township's littering and storm water ordinances.

Grass clippings, leaves, and other lawn debris can clog storm drains, resulting in street and private property flooding. Also, storm drains flow directly to local waterways untreated. Grass clippings add unnecessary nutrients, which help feed harmful algal blooms. In addition to environmental harm, you may be creating a safety hazard. When blown into the street, clippings can create a slippery and dangerous surface for traveling motorcyclists and bicyclists.

Using a mulching mower puts clippings back into the turf and keeps the nutrients where they belong. Should you choose to use a discharging mower, please be sure to point the blower toward your property (away from the street) to prevent clippings from leaving the lawn. When finished mowing, please be sure to use a blower, broom, or rake to clean up any grass clippings or debris that have inadvertently made their way into the street, sidewalk, or storm drain.
