- ❖ The only father-daughter collaboration to hit the top spot on the Billboard pop music chart was the 1967 hit single "Something Stupid" by Frank & Nancy Sinatra.

Pooh was based on Robin's teddy bear, Edward, a gift Christopher had received for his first birthday, and on their father/son visits to the London Zoo, where the bear named Winnie was Christopher's favorite. Pooh comes from the name of Christopher's pet swan.

White Goods Pickup Public Works will resume pickup of white goods (all appliances) starting on July 10th. You must call the Township to schedule a pickup of these items. Please contact Rupi Swaitch at rswaitch@eastampton.com or 609-267-5723 ext. 200.

Brush Collection We are pleased to announce that Public Works will resume brush pickup starting June 1st. Brush chipping is done the first full week of every month except when the first Monday is a holiday. When the first Monday is a holiday, brush collection will be done the following week. In the event of inclement weather, brush will be collected the following week as well. Residents are reminded to place brush curbside at the front of their home by 7:00am on the first day of scheduled collection. Branches should be longer than (4) four feet and not exceed (8) eight inches in diameter. All butt ends must face the same direction for ease of loading. Sticks and branches less than (4) four feet in length should be tied in bundles that weigh no more than (50) fifty pounds.

Bulky waste consists of items such as old furniture, bedding, carpeting, pool covers and metal items such as bicycles. No waste materials of any kind that are generated from commercial activities or businesses, including handyman, repair services, retail store, offices, real estate agencies, landlords, contractors, agricultural enterprises.

Residents doing minor repairs to the primary residence may put out small amounts of debris on their bulk day.

Concrete/cinder blocks, bricks and stone are considered construction debris and will not be accepted.

If a building permit was required for the work that generated waste then it is considered construction debris. Absolutely no contractors or landlords will be permitted to dispose of construction or demolition debris. Primary Election

Tuesday, June 16, 2020 is the deadline for registering to vote in time for the July 7th Primary Election. Residents can check their voter registration status online by using the "Registration Resources" link on the County Clerk's Burlington County Clerk's website page.

Reminder, residents who are currently age 17 can sign up now to automatically register to vote when you turn 18. Seventeen-year olds who sign up for automatic registration on or before June 16th, and who will turn 18 by July7th, are eligible to participate in the Primary Election.



July 7, 2020

Polls open 6:00 am- 8:00pm

- In direct response to the COVID-19 Pandemic and in accordance to Executive Order 144 the 2020 Primary election will be held on July 7, 2020
- Election will primarily be VOTE-BY-MAIL
- If you go to a polling location you will ONLY be allowed to do a **PROVISIONAL BALLOT**
- All voters will receive a vote by mail ballot and return postage paid envelope
- All active Republicans and Democrats will receive a vote by mail ballot and return postage paid envelope
- All Unaffiliated and Inactive voters will receive a vote by mail application and return postage paid envelope
- Ballots **CANNOT** be returned to polling locations
- ONLY VOTERS WITH DISABLITIES preventing them from vote using a paper ballot will be able to vote on ADA-accessible machines at polling location
- There will be limited polling locations available
- The Deadline to Register to vote is June 16, 2020
