Eastampton Township News is generally published on a monthly basis to provide residents with pertinent information and reminders related to Eastampton Township and the surrounding area. The Township views this as another important means of keeping residents informed about our community.



General Election is <u>Tuesday</u>, <u>November 6</u> from 6a.m. - 8p.m. Individuals also can **Vote by Mail**. The deadline to apply for vote by mail ballot is *Tuesday*, *October 30* by mail and *Monday*, *November 6* by 3pm in person. Registration forms and vote by mail application forms can be obtained online at <u>www.njelections.org</u>. Questions can be directed to the Municipal Clerk's office at 609 267-5723, ext. 209.

Vote by Mail Voters may apply for a ballot in-person in the county clerk's office anytime up to 3 p.m. on the day before an election. Ballots issued over-the-counter may be taken directly to the Board of Elections on the first floor at 50 Rancocas Road to be voted and turned in.

Voters also have the option of returning their ballot by mail. Voted ballots must be received by the Board of Elections before polls close on the day of the election when delivered in person. A mailed ballot may be postmarked by Election Day and must be received by the Board of Elections within 48 hours to be counted.



Tax Payments are due **November 1**st, for your convenience we have a tax payment box that you may drop your payment. If your tax payment is made after November 12th you will be subject to Tax Sale in December.

REMINDER: Eastampton Township Now Accepting Online Tax Payments. Residents can make payments online via ACH, e-check, credit card or debit card by visiting <u>https://wipp.edmundsassoc.com/Wipp/?wippid=0311</u>. Attention Residents: Tax Sale Information. All unpaid property taxes, sewer or other municipal charges which remain unpaid as of November 12, 2018 are subject to the annual Municipal Tax Sale scheduled for December 12, 2018. Attention Residents: <u>Trash Collection Schedule for Week of</u> <u>Thanksgiving</u>. Township offices are closed on Thursday, November 22 and Friday, November 23. Therefore, trash collection for residents whose trash is normally collected on Thursdays will be collected on Monday, November 19. Tuesday and Wednesday trash collection will not be affected. Recreation Events

Township Sponsors Free Rabies Clinic for Dogs and Cats on <u>Saturday</u>, <u>November 10</u> from 10:00am to 11:00am. The program will be conducted at the Recreation Building, located in Buttonwood Park (7 Knightsbridge Road). Please be advised that owners must provide proof of current rabies in order to receive a three (3) year vaccine. If proof of current rabies is not provided, a one (1) year vaccine will be administered. For everyone's safety, all animals must be properly restrained by leash or carrier. Please note that this program is for <u>rabies vaccinations only</u>. Licensing will begin in January, including special licensing hours on Saturday, January 13, 2019 from 9:30am to 12:30pm. Brush & Leaf Collection



Eastampton Township Brush Collection Schedule

Reminder. Brush chipping is done the first full week of every month except when the first Monday is a holiday. When the first Monday is a holiday, brush collection will be done the following week. In the event of inclement weather, brush will be collected the following week as well. Residents are reminded to place brush curbside at the front of their home by 7:00am on the first day of scheduled collection. Branches should be longer than (4) four feet and not exceed (8) eight inches in diameter. All butt ends must face the same direction for ease of loading. Sticks and branches less than (4) four feet in length should be tied in bundles that weigh no more than (50) fifty pounds. Please keep sidewalks and pathways clear for pedestrian and bicycle traffic. Eastampton Township Leaf Collection Information. Leaf collection begins the <u>week of October 15</u> and will be collected through January, 2019. Residents can bag leaves or rake them to the curb for collection. Leaves should be placed in the grass strip between the curb and sidewalk, not in the street. Leaves should not be placed near fire hydrants, sign posts, portable basketball hoops, or telephone poles. Leaves must be free of all trash, sticks, branches, vines, rocks, dirt, and debris. Mixed material will not be collected.
