Eastampton Township News is generally published on a monthly basis to provide residents with pertinent information and reminders related to Eastampton Township and the surrounding area. The Township views this as another important means of keeping residents informed about our community.

- 1. <u>Tax Bills</u>. Eastampton Township earlier this week received final tax rate documentation from Burlington County. The Township anticipates mailing tax bills to residents beginning on or about <u>August 8</u>. Residents will have <u>25 days</u> from the date of the tax bill mailing to pay their 3rd Quarter taxes without penalty. - 2. NO TAX RATE INCREASE 2018 Municipal Budget Adopted by Eastampton Township Council in April for fifth consecutive year. Thus, the 2018 municipal tax rate component remains the same, at the rate of 85 cents per \$100 of assessed valuation. This means that for the average current residential assessment of \$221,149.00, the 2018 municipal tax is \$1,881.98. The Eastampton municipal component is approximately 27% of the total local property tax bill. The 2018 municipal tax levy also is well below the available state cap levy amounts. The fiscally conservative budget document also will continue to deliver a very high quality level of services to residents. The NO TAX RATE INCREASE municipal budget is a result of the Township's commitment to continually seek out additional efficiencies, cooperative purchasing avenues and service sharing opportunities, a low debt

level, and pro-active efforts to carefully plan and to closely monitor expenditures and revenues throughout the year.

- 3. REMINDER: Eastampton Township Now Accepting Online Tax Payments. Residents can make payments online via ACH, e-check, credit card or debit card by visiting https://wipp.edmundsassoc.com/Wipp/?wippid=0311. - 4. American Water Performing Water Main Replacement Work on Smithville-Jacksonville Road, Kent Court, Surrey Court, Lancashire Drive, East Darby Circle and West Darby Circle. Work will be conducted Monday through Friday from 7:00am to 4:00pm and is expected to be completed by Friday, August 10, weather permitting. Pioneer Pipe is performing the work associated with this project. Police officers will be directing traffic, but motorists should expect delays due to alternating traffic and signed detours. - 5. PSE&G Gas Service Project Continues on Woodlane Road, from Jacksonville Road to Smithville Road. Work will be conducted Monday through Friday from 9:00am to 6:00pm. Motorists should expect delays due to alternating traffic and signed detours. Additional project information can be found by contacting 1-833-661-6400.
- 6. PSE&G Continues Milling and Paving in The Vistas Section of the Township. The restoration work is required as a result of the recently completed gas main upgrades and will be performed on Stonegate Drive, Brook Run Road, Farmdale Road, Cedar Mill Lane, Tollhouse Road and Shelter Rock Road. Work will be conducted Monday through Friday from 7:00am to 6:00pm and is expected to be completed by August 3, weather permitting. - 14. Fieldstone Associates, LLC Continues Site Work on Eastampton Place West on Woodlane Road, the Former Gregory's Furniture Site. Fieldstone Associates, LLC received Land Use Planning Board approval for a mix-use project on the site. "Eastampton Place West" consists of 7 buildings totaling approximately 383,000 square feet, including over 12,000 square feet of commercial space, a 4,300 square foot clubhouse and 240 market-rate luxury apartment units ranging from 800 to 1,400 square feet each. The property is located adjacent to the existing Dunkin Donuts on Woodlane Road. Occupancy is scheduled to begin in 2018. Work is scheduled to be performed on weekdays, weather permitting, from 7am to 4pm. Work will occasionally be conducted on Saturdays during the same hours. Township Engineer Environmental Resolutions is managing project oversight.
- Village II and III on Woodlane Road. The project, consisting of 8 market-rate single family homes and 55 market-rate townhomes, constructed by Ryan Homes, is located adjacent to the existing Sharbell development. Work is scheduled to be performed on weekdays, weather permitting, from 7am to 4pm. Work will occasionally be conducted on Saturdays during the same hours. Although vehicular traffic may be impacted in this area, roads will remain open throughout the project. Township Engineer Environmental Resolutions is managing project oversight.
