- <u>Attention Residents</u>: Trash Collection Schedule for Week of 4<sup>th</sup> of July. Township offices are closed on <u>Wednesday</u>, July 4. Therefore, trash collection for all residents whose trash is normally collected on Wednesday will be collected on <u>Friday</u>, July 6. Tuesday and Thursday trash will not be affected. - 2. **PSE&G Gas Service Project Delayed and is Currently Scheduled to Begin On or About July 9.** PSE&G will be installing new gas services along Woodlane Road, from Jacksonville Road to Smithville Road. Work will be conducted Monday through Friday from 9:00am to 6:00pm. Motorists should expect delays due to alternating traffic and signed detours. - 3. **PSE&G to Perform Milling and Paving Beginning the Week of** July 16, Weather Permitting. The restoration work is required as a result of the recently completed gas main upgrades and will be performed on Stonegate Drive, Brook Run Road, Farmdale Road, Cedar Mill Lane, Tollhouse Road and Shelter Rock Road. Work will be conducted Monday through Friday from 7:00am to 6:00pm. Police Officers will be directing traffic, but motorists should expect some delays. - 7. Township Awarded 2017 Clean Communities Grant of \$11,602.79. New Jersey Clean Communities is a state-wide litter abatement program created by State legislation and managed by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection and the Clean Communities Council. The Clean Communities Act establishes a funding mechanism for the program by placing a user fee on manufacturers, wholesalers and distributors who produce litter-generating products.
- 8. Eastampton Township Brush Collection. Due to several unforeseen circumstances, the Public Works Department's normal brush collection schedule has been suspended. As such, residents will see both our chipper and trash trucks collecting brush throughout the week. However, please understand that trash trucks cannot collect brush while they are collecting normal trash due to the manner in which the material is required to be disposed. - 10. **Burlington County Smithville Road Bridge.** Burlington County has begun repairs to the Smithville Road Bridge. Work is scheduled to continue throughout the year and Smithville Road is scheduled to be open to thru traffic in December. - 13. Fieldstone Associates, LLC Continues Site Work on Eastampton Place West on Woodlane Road, the Former Gregory's Furniture Site. Fieldstone Associates, LLC received Land Use Planning Board approval for a mix-use project on the site. "Eastampton Place West" consists of 7 buildings totaling approximately 383,000 square feet, including over 12,000 square feet of commercial space, a 4,300 square foot clubhouse and 240 market-rate luxury apartment units ranging from 800 to 1,400 square feet each. The

property is located adjacent to the existing Dunkin Donuts on Woodlane Road. Occupancy is scheduled to begin in 2018. Work is scheduled to be performed on weekdays, weather permitting, from 7am to 4pm. Work will occasionally be conducted on Saturdays during the same hours. Township Engineer Environmental Resolutions is managing project oversight.

14. Holgate Development, LLC Continues Construction on Eastampton Village II and III on Woodlane Road. The project, consisting of 8 market-rate single family homes and 55 market-rate townhomes, constructed by Ryan Homes, is located adjacent to the existing Sharbell development. Work is scheduled to be performed on weekdays, weather permitting, from 7am to 4pm. Work will occasionally be conducted on Saturdays during the same hours. Although vehicular traffic may be impacted in this area, roads will remain open throughout the project. Township Engineer Environmental Resolutions is managing project oversight.
