Eastampton Township News

Eastampton Township News is generally published on a monthly basis to provide residents with pertinent information and reminders related to Eastampton Township and the surrounding area. The Township views this as another important means of keeping residents informed about our community.

- 1. Eastampton Township Awarded \$167,000 New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) 2016 Municipal Aid Program Grant for "Safe Streets to Transit" Along Woodlane Road. The award, successfully obtained by Eastampton Township Council, will enable the Township to begin a project which will enhance and extend sidewalks along Woodlane Road and increase both pedestrian and bicycle traffic throughout the area.
- 2. Eastampton Township Awarded \$115,000 Burlington County 2015 Park Development Program Grant. The award, successfully obtained by Eastampton Township Council, will enable the Township to continue Cliver Park improvements including the completion of the park pathway and expansion of the parking lot.
- 3. Holgate Development, LLC Begins Site Work on Eastampton Village II and III on Woodlane Road. The project, consisting of eight (8) single family homes and fifty-five (55) townhomes, received Land Use Planning Board approval in 2015 and is located on Woodlane Road. Work is scheduled to be

performed on weekdays, weather permitting, from 7 am to 6 pm. Work will occasionally be conducted on Saturdays during the same hours. Although vehicular traffic may be impacted in this area, roads will remain open throughout the project. Construction work is being performed by Blenheim Construction of Sicklerville and Township Engineer Environmental Resolutions is managing project oversight. Progress and timelines will be provided throughout the project via all Township information outlets.

4. Eastampton Township Community Slogan. Eastampton Township recently embarked on an exercise to develop and articulate a community brand. Residents provided important input which assisted the Township in identifying several community themes. When completed, Township Council will be adopting brand identifiers, including a community slogan, which will be used to market and promote the Township. A well-developed brand is necessary to highlight Eastampton Township as a welcoming community. The brand development process involves public participation to ensure that the final product accurately represents the benefits of living and working in Eastampton.
