## **INSPECTIONS:**

I have sent a second letter to the Division of Fire Safety informing them that I will stay on as the Fire Official until January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2024. This is to make whatever transition takes place with the LEA smoother and without any interruption in service.

Inspector Boduroglu will be completing the final Life Hazard Use inspections between now and the end of the year.

The Township zoning officer has informed me that there is another new business going in where the old hair salon was on Monmouth Road.

The Division of Fire Safety has sent me an email informing me that certain information entered into the new Fire Dynamics program did not save. Many townships will have to re-enter the information after next week.

I contacted our State Fire Safety representative Dwayne Breeden about how the Commissioners are supposed to sign off on the 2023 year end report and district supplemental report. Currently there is NO WAY for them to sign off until a new module is completed for the Fire Dynamics program. When that is finished the Chairman of the Board will have to create an account and then complete the signature.

## **COMPLAINTS:**

There was one formal complaint last week on Ella Lane. Inspector Boduroglu responded to a resident open burning on a second floor wood deck in a Multi-family dwelling. The fire was extinguished and the homeowner advised as to the danger of the location and issued a warning. I will be contacting the HOA and remind them to send a cover letter to all the residents informing them of the Open Burning regulations.

## **FIRE INVESTIGATIONS:**

I completed the Fire Report for the boat fire on Monmouth road last month. Several copies were sent to insurance company's and prints of the Fire Investigation filed.

#### TRAINING:

I will be attending a recertification class at Burlington County Fire Academy next month on NFPA and sprinkler systems design.

## KNOX BOX PROGRAM:

There were no new Knox Box applications or key updates last month.

## GENERAL BUREAU INFORMATION

I and the Inspector attended the October Township meeting to address any questions about the Fire Bureau possibly moving back under Township rule. Several Fire Company members were on hand to lend their support and give opinions on keeping the Local Enforcing Agency within the town. Several points of discussion were talked about.

This Saturday night Yunus will be inspection the Township's Bonfire Pit for the Halloween Event at the park. Currently there are 3 Vendors that will need permits and inspections prior to the event. This will take place around 4:30 pm on Saturday, November 28th.
